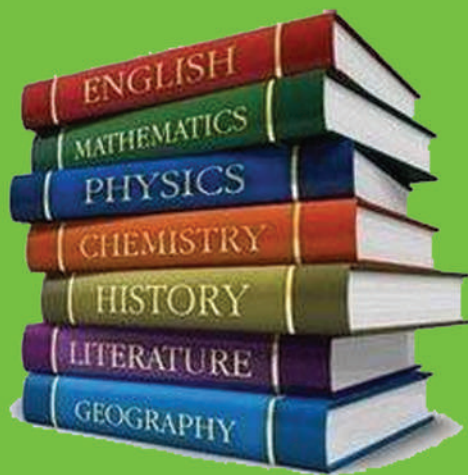


HISTORY OF THE SCHOOL

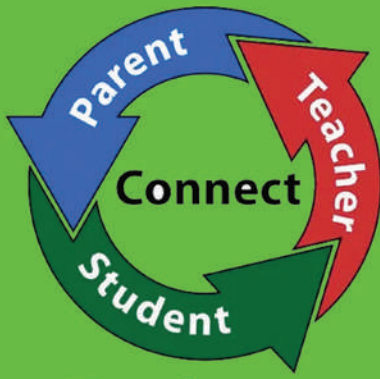
Montfort school, is a Catholic English Medium school, established in 2002, under the Meghalaya Board of School Education. It is administered by the society of the Montfort Brothers of St. Gabriel, a Congregation founded in France in 1705 by St. Louis Marie Grignon De Montfort (1673-1716). Following the footsteps of St. Montfort, who was a great missionary, three French Brothers came to India in the year 1903. They established schools and other Educational Institutions to cater to the educational needs of the youth. Today the society administers about 196 educational institutions spread over 18 states in India. Montfort Brothers of St. Gabriel is today an international organization working in 33 countries in the world. The Brothers are actively involved in the promotion of education and culture through Academic schools, Junior Colleges, schools for the Blind and Deaf, Teacher Training Institutes, Industrial Training Institutes, Vocational Training Centres, Youth Centres, Orphanages, homes for the aged,

COURSE OF STUDIES

The course of studies is prescribed by the Meghalaya Board of School Education (MBOSE). The Meghalaya Board has adopted the CBSE syllabus and pattern of examination from 2002 onwards. The students are prepared for the Secondary School Leaving Certificate Examination (SSLC) at the end of Class 10 and Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate (HSSLC) at the end of Class 12.



WORKING HOURS



1. Students should be in the school campus by 8: 45 a.m. Students should be in the school campus by 8:40 a.m on all working days.
2. The lunch interval is of 20 minutes duration, no student will be allowed to leave the school premises during any breaks.

3. The afternoon session ends at 3:10 p.m. However if the teachers so decide, students may be required to stay on till 04:00 p.m. for extra class, practice etc.
4. The school bus conveyance will not be available for any special classes.

TO THE PARENTS

1. Parents are encouraged to meet the school authorities at least once in a term to enquire about the performance of their wards.
2. They have to make sure that their children attend the classes daily and punctually, in neat uniform.
3. Parents must see that their children study at home, complete their Assignments and Homework on time.
4. They should go through the school diary to acquaint themselves with the rules and regulations of the school. They should go through their different records on a weekly basis and sign wherever necessary.
5. Parents/Guardians are not permitted to go to the class rooms during class hours in order to meet their children or teachers without the permission of the principal.
6. Parents should see that, they pay the school fees of their children before the 15th of every month without fail.
7. No one except those authorized in writing by the parents of the child will be allowed to take the student out of the school during the working hours.
8. Parents must report for parents meeting in the school on time thus teaching their children the value of punctuality.
9. At the end of the terminal examinations, the parents may be expected to collect their son's/daughter's progress report and discuss with the teachers about the progress and other aspects of their child's life in the school.
10. Parents/Guardians need to seek admission to Montfort School only if they agree to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the school.
11. Parents who claim to be busy to meet the Principal/Teachers when required in connection with their child's progress in the school need not seek admission for their children.

BUS FACILITY

1. Bus facility is provided to all who apply for the same. [Form No.5]
 2. If there are insufficient students on any route, that route will be taken off from school bus service.
 3. Students who wish to travel by school bus have to pay the fees regularly.
 4. Parents / Guardians / unauthorized persons are not allowed to use the bus service.
 5. Students availing the school bus service are not allowed to withdraw in the middle of the session (unless they are taking TC) and will have to continue for the full academic year failing which they will be considered defaulters.
 6. Parents are to instruct their children;
 - a. Once boarding the bus, not to get down from the bus except at the destination
 - b. Not to board running buses
 - c. While travelling by the school bus, to avoid boisterous talking, howling, misbehaving with passers-by, travelling on the footboard and running around in the bus
 - d. Not to damage the seat covers seats etc of the buses. Should any damage be done the concerned student(s) will have to bear the cost of repair / replacement.
- If necessary, the bus service of a student can be terminated on any of the above grounds.
